Message from the Finance Committee Family Offering, Christmas and Easter Offerings

As you may be aware, tax relief exists whereby those who contribute €250 or more to a charity in a given tax year can allow the charity to draw down an additional sum (equal to almost 45% of the donation) from the Revenue Commissioners, which is sent directly to the parish. It is important to say that there is no loss or cost incurred by any taxpayer who is willing to be part of this system and that confidentiality will be assured in all aspects of this process.

For a person who contributes exactly €250 in any tax year – it is possible for the Parish to receive an additional €112.32 from the Revenue Commissioners. If the amount donated to the Church is in excess of €250, then this figure will increase accordingly.

This claim can be backdated for four years, so the finance committee are reaching out in the next week or two to the many generous contributors who have in the past donated €250 or more with further instructions on how you may help us in this pursuit.
