- Where a family wishes to register, a single family leader will register all members. Adult fees apply; all children under 18 are free but must be registered to have access to the venue.
- You can book for the Festival of Families Saturday event or the Mass on Sunday at time of registration. It cannot be added afterwards. Children cannot be registered on their own; they must be registered with a minimum of one adult through the family group registration option.
