The **WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY** will be observed as usual from the 18th - 25th January 2019. Its inauguration in Dublin will take place at an Interdenominational Service in the Church of St. John the Baptist, Church of Ireland, Seafield Road West, Clontarf, Dublin 3, on Friday, 18th January, at 8pm. The Very Reverend Fachtna McCarthy, from Haddington Road, will preach the sermon.

This year the theme, "Only Justice" (Deut 16: 18-20), was chosen by the Christian Communities from Indonesia to help them reflect on 'how do divisions in society contribute to divisions in the Church?'

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is a privileged moment of prayer, encounter and dialogue. It is an opportunity to recognise and receive the richness and value that are present in the other, the different, and to ask God for the gift of unity.

Pope Francis in his Apostolic Exhortation *Evangelii Gaudium* writes: "The immense numbers of people who have not received the Gospel of Jesus Christ cannot leave us indifferent. Consequently, commitment to a unity which helps them to accept Jesus Christ can no longer be a matter of mere diplomacy or forced compliance, but rather an indispensable path to evangelisation"(E.G. 246).
