**SUGGESTED PRACTICAL ACTIONS FOR  
PARISHIONERS DURING THE SEASON  
OF CREATION, 2019:**

- \*Spend some time outside each day.
- \*Start to grow some of your own food;  
support local producers .
- \*Compost your garden and food waste.
- \*Avoid or reduce the use of chemicals in  
your home and garden .
- \*Use (vinegar, baking soda) and buy eco-  
friendly cleaners
- \*Plant pollinator friendly plants in your  
window box or/ and garden at home or/  
and in your parish grounds.
- \*Shop wisely-Buy Fairtrade and buy  
locally made products when possible .
- \*Avoid waste. Avoid, reduce, reuse,  
recycle, recover, treat, dispose.

**PLASTIC**

- \*Refuse single use plastics such as cling  
film, straws, plastic cutlery.
- \*Switch to a reusable water bottle /travel  
cup.
- \*Use cloth bags for shopping and \*Bring/  
Use your own containers when possible.
- \*Check for and then avoid microbeads in  
products . Refuse packaging.
- \*Avoid - Reduce - Re-use - Recycle -
