**World Meeting of Families**

The World Meeting of Families which takes place from August 21st to 26th in Dublin is a momentous and historic occasion for the Irish Church made even more so by the announcement that Pope Francis will be present in Dublin. It promises to be a grace filled occasion for those who attend.

At present the tickets for the Festival of Families in Croke Park on 25th and the Closing Mass in the Phoenix Park on 26th are not directly available on general release until consultations with the relevant statutory authorities on capacity, transport, security, safety and other issues. **When these tickets become available they will be free.**

Those hoping to attend the Final Mass in Phoenix Park are asked to expect an approximate a 2 kilometer or more walk from where they park or are dropped by bus to the Mass venue due to security, safety and transport considerations.

The excellent programme of the three-day Pastoral Congress for WMOF2018, from 22nd to 24th August will take place in the RDS and will offer a daily programme of workshops, discussions as well as fun and prayerful activities for individuals and families .
