St. John Vianney's Bi-Centenary

Tuesday 13 February is the 200th Anniversary of St John Vianney, the Curé of Ars, going to the small parish of Ars, France, which he transformed and which became a centre of worldwide pilgrimage. The Curé of Ars is the Patron of Confessions and of Priests. To mark this occasion the Parish of St John Vianney, Ardlea Road, Artane, will be having a special Mass at 10.00 am on Tuesday 13 February, celebrated by the new **Apostolic Delegate, Archbishop Okolo**. There will also be Evening Prayer and **Benediction at 7.30 pm on 13 February**. There will be Veneration of the Relics and Confession after each service.

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament takes place from after 12.30 pm Mass each Sunday, concluding with **Rosary & Benediction at 5 pm.**

LENT 2018 in St. Brendan's

The call of Lent is summed up in the words "Come back to me with all your heart with fasting, praying, alms-giving". It's a springtime season, a great season where we can get in 'transformation' mode! What does God want us to be, to do? We usually give something up, but remember it's not simply about weight loss or getting fit. By doing these things we are trying to make room for something deeper. It's a spring cleaning sort of time. What needs clearing out in my life so that I can make more room for God? We can get stuck, especially when we are comfortable and don't really want too much to change. But without change we can't grow and things fast become stale in our lives. God is always urging us on because God knows just what possibilities there are for each of us. So Lent might be a time where in giving up something or taking on something, we make space for something new. How we make use of this time determines what will be.

In St Brendan's we are invited, during Lent, to participate in:

- * Eucharist on Ash Wednesday at 8am, 10am, 1.10pm, and 7.30pm (with the distribution of Ashes after each Eucharist)
- * Weekday Masses at 8am, 10 am, 1.10pm.
- * Adoration - 3pm - 5.30pm (Monday - Thursday)
- * Adoration on Sunday from 1.15pm - 5pm followed by Rosary and Benediction
- * Trocaire Campaign by taking a box. A representative from Trocaire will speak at a Sunday Mass on their work in Sierra Leone
- * Parish Novena on the theme of 'Family' from Sunday March 4th - Monday March 12th (different speakers each night).
- * Sacrament of Reconciliation on Tuesday March 27th at 7.30pm (Fr Alan Hilliard)
