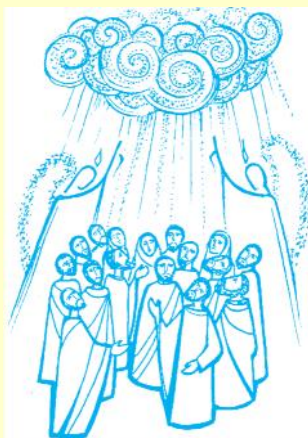

Certainly, a quotation that has relevance for us in Ireland today as we will be inundated with propaganda as to why we must be 'tolerant' when considering how to cast our vote in the upcoming Referendum on 25th May.

"I did not speak out because it doesn't apply to me right now"
