TROCAIRE 2022

This year we are invited to support *the people of Zimbabwe*. The family on the box are Thandekile and her children. Three droughts, a cyclone, flooding – all the results of a changing climate they had little hand in causing – left the family unable to reliably grow their own food. Covid claimed the life of Thandekile's husband Donovan in a matter of days – a loss so sudden that her children, Nomatter (11) & Forward (8) still find hard to accept that the father they loved is gone. She became a widow at 31. The pandemic has brought more poverty and hardship. To date, Trocaire has completed

9 programmes, including rehabilitating small-scale dams, installing solar water pumping systems, sustainable community gardens, and bringing emergency food relief to

10 schools and many villages. Let your love help them build a better tomorrow and a better world for everyone.
