Trócaire face-to-face fundraising .

In the Republic of Ireland, a return to face-to-face fundraising, in line with government guidelines, has been sanctioned by Charities Institute Ireland and the Charity Regulator in May. A number of other charities recommenced face-to-face fundraising activities on the 17th May.

I would like to inform you that Trócaire will now relaunch activity in the **on 21st June.**

We will be working with small roaming teams across the country. Although we will only be in a couple of locations at any given time, this means you or your parishioners may see fundraisers either in or outside shops or calling door-to-door in your parish, inviting members of the public to become monthly donors to Trocaire.

Fundraisers will wear Trócaire branded jackets/t-shirts/face masks and carry Trócaire ID cards.

They will be trained by Trócaire staff members in relation to the safeguarding of vulnerable members of the public and will comply with all Covid-19 guidelines and restrictions. An Adult Faith Development Programme

Applications are now open for the next intake of participants for *Pathways*. This programme is run by the Archdiocese of Dublin. It will begin in DCU St. Patrick's Campus, (MDCCE), Drumcondra Rd. Dublin, 9. on **Thursday 30th September 2021 (7.00p.m. – 9.30 p.m.)**. **Places are limited so early application is advised.**

Pathways is a two-year, one night a week, course for adults of all ages who wish to explore their faith. It runs from late September to May each year. There are no exams and no written work. The only requirement is an openness to listening to others and to participate. You can just come along and enjoy! The cost is €400 for the coming year which may be paid in instalments. Some sponsorship may be available for those of limited means.
