The Peter McVerry Trust Wexford Cycle will help open doors for people impacted by homelessness across Ireland.

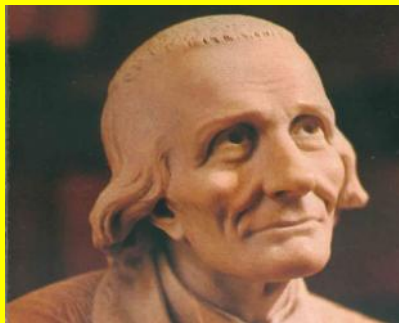
Age Action's Getting Started Digital Training Programme
